

*Government Notice No. 134 of 2026***THE WASTE WATER MANAGEMENT AUTHORITY ACT****Regulations made by the Minister under section 47 of
the Waste Water Management Authority Act**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Waste Water (Application and Processing Fee and Waste Water Connection Fee) Regulations 2026.
2. In these regulations –
 - “domestic consumer” means an owner or occupier of a property to whom the Central Water Authority has agreed to supply water for domestic purposes;
 - “non-domestic consumer” means a consumer other than a domestic consumer.
3. (1) Any non-domestic consumer who intends to connect his property to the public sewer system shall make an application to the Authority in the form set out in the First Schedule.
 - (2) The application shall be accompanied by –
 - (a) a non-refundable application and processing fee specified in the Second Schedule payable when the technical feasibility of connection is ascertained by the Authority; and
 - (b) a copy of the Central Water Authority bill, site location plan, National Identity Card, title deed, business registration number and other such documents, as the Authority may require.

4. On receipt of an application under regulation 3, the Authority shall carry out a joint survey with the Applicant for a preliminary field reconnaissance to assess the feasibility of the connection.
5. Where the Authority determines, following the conduct of the joint survey under regulation 4, that the connection is feasible, and has agreed to connect the said property to the public sewer system, it may approve the application and –
 - (a) notify the applicant in writing of the Authority's approval; and
 - (b) require the applicant to pay a connection fee based on the cost of connection works.
6. (1) The applicant shall, within a period of 6 months from the date he is informed of the decision of the Authority, pay the connection fee specified in regulation 5(b).

(2) Where the applicant fails to comply with paragraph (1) within the delay specified therein, it may, not later than 30 days after the expiry of the delay, pay the connection fee together with a surcharge of 10 per cent.
7. Where the applicant fails to comply with regulation 6, he shall be deemed not to be proceeding with the application.
8. These regulations shall come into operation on 1 August 2026.
